Dale Hicks is a 1957 Martinsburg High School graduate. Upon graduation, Mr. Hicks attended Shepherd College and graduated in 1961. Mr. Hicks had a 37 year teaching career at Martinsburg High School and has devoted his life to serving MHS. Mr. Hicks received his Master's Degree from Shippensburg University and completed post masters work at WVU. While teaching at MHS, Mr. Hicks produced 28 yearbooks, taught honors English, worked with the students on the school newspaper, and at one time or another, sponsored just about every club at MHS. From 1961 to 1964, he was the Key club advisor for MHS even though he did not work here at that time. He also sponsored senior trips to New York, Philadelphia, Washington and Baltimore from 1969 to 1991. From 1992-2001, he sponsored curriculum trips to these same places for the Art, Drama, Music and English departments. In 1978, Mr. Hicks was the Berkeley County Teacher of the Year and was named one of the five top teachers in West Virginia.

Mr. Hicks has remained extremely active at MHS since his retirement. He is involved with the Alumni Association and the Turf Fund. He has been the treasurer for both of these organizations.
